LIVELIHOOD IN ARGENTINA









COVID-19 pandemic posed significant challenges, especially for those who are vulnerable. Within this context, the results of a national survey carried out to learn about the economic situation and the physical and emotional health of the population within the world of work are presented below:

The main goals were the following:

- **1** To monitor the economic situation and the ability to meet the basic needs.
- **2** To expose the work problems product of the pandemic.
- **3** To analyze the current physical and emotional health at the work environment.





Results were analyzed according to the main sociodemographic variables, being the socioeconomic status the one that conditioned the results the most.


This survey is framed within a larger program developed by the Humanitarian Observatory of the Argentine Red Cross.








MARITAL STATUS




SATISFACTION WITH THE EMPLOYMENT SITUATION



PREFERRED WORK MODALITY


If you could choose, in which modality would you prefer to work?




Has anyone at your home been suspended or did he/she suffer a reduction in his/her incomes due to the pandemic?





Are you very, quite, little or not at all worried about losing your job or the source of income of your household?





 Do you believe that it will be very, quite, moderately or not at all easy to find a job that allows you make ends meet?








RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FAMILY AND WORK LIFE






FAMILY DEMAND



CONCLUSIONS

BASED ON THE MAIN RESULTS OF THE RESEARCH THE CONCLUSIONS ARE PRESENTED BELOW:

- 44% of the respondents prefer hybrid systems of work, next to it the 35% want to work in person at the office and a 16% chose virtual mode.
 Nevertheless, the 83% say that most of the days work from the office.
- **2** A series of indicators show the financial context of the respondents in relation to the pandemic:
 - a) 18% say that someone of working-age at the household lost his/her job due to the pandemic. From that total, 52% were able to get a new job.





- b) 33% say that someone at the household was suspended or suffered a reduction in his/her incomes due to the pandemic. disminuidos sus ingresos como consecuencia de la pandemia.
- **c) 81%** of the respondents say to have some difficulty to make ends meet.
- **d) 85%** of the people that receive help from institutions to cover the basic needs have interest in getting a formal job.
- e) Indicators are accentuated according to the incomes of the people, being the people with fewer incomes the most financially affected by the pandemic.
- Sobre la salud mental en el trabajo:
 - a) 72% of the respondents that work say that can correctly balance their family and work life. This percentage lowers among people of low socioeconomic status.
 - b) From the respondents that can not balance their family and work life, 44% accepts it and feels guilty about it.
 - **c) 34%** of the respondents that work manifest to have a bad occupational health due to physical or emotional reasons.
 - d) Nevertheless, 85% say to feel the need of doing things for themselves besides working. Also, 65% point out physical and emotional exhaustion. However, 76% feels that their work is appreciated.

Studied population:

People who participated in the program of Livelihood of the Argentine Red Cross.



Methodology: In person.



Sample characteristics: The field operation was deployed in 20 provinces across the country.



Number of surveys: 1517 cases.



Statistical error:

Statistical error is not calculated because it is not a probabilistic sample. As an informative data, a probabilistic sample with this number of surveys has a +/- 2.6% margin oferror for a trust level of 95%.
